La MaMa has gone all out for its dance festival, **LA MAMA MOVES!**, and there is still plenty of great dance to be seen before it ends on June 1. A weekend of “Male Bonding” between the excellent and varied choreographers Andrew Dinwiddie, Miguel Gutierrez, John Jasperse, Nicholas Leichter, Ben Munisteri and John Scott ends on Sunday at 5:30 at the Club, while an 8 p.m. show on the first floor wraps up “New York International.” For the Uruguayan choreographer Luciana Achugar alone, this should not be missed.

Meanwhile, the Annex will be hopping. There is a Sunday matinee, “Loco-Motion Dance Theater for Children” (2:30 p.m.).
