★ **DV8 PHYSICAL THEATER** (Thursday) As the name of the company indicates, DV8 makes works that combine movement and theater in somewhat indefinable ways. The company, directed by Lloyd Newson, has been an important and influential presence on the British scene for more than two decades, but it hasn't been to the United States for 15 years. Luckily, DV8 will present "To Be Straight With You" as part of Montclair State University's excellent Peak Performances series. For this work, Mr. Newson and his collaborators interviewed 85 people about their feelings about homosexuality and religion. Mr. Newson's vivid visual imagination and theatrical skills make it likely that what he has done with those words will make for compelling, thought-provoking viewing. (Through Oct. 5.)
