### Peak Performances Announces New Season

The innovative Peak Performances series at Montclair State University in New Jersey has announced its 2010-11 season, running from Sept. 1 through May 8, which begins with "Everywhere Is the Best Seat," a sound-and-light installation by the architect and composer **Christopher Janney**, who is known for creating sonic and light environments in public spaces. The lineup also includes a revival of the 1998 play "Jet Lag," opening on Sept. 23. Conceived by the New York theater company Builders Association and the New York architecture team Diller Scofidio & Renfro, it is a story based on two tragic incidents that deal with the uses and abuses of technology. And "Double Vision," a multimedia dance performance presented by **Carolyn Carlson** that runs from Oct. 14 to 17. Other performers include the jazz composer and pianist **Fred Hersch**; the Belgian theater director and artist **Jan Fabre**; and the performance artist **Robert Whiteman**. Choreographers are well represented too, among them **Crystal Pite**, **Liz Lerman** and **Robyn Orlin**.
