

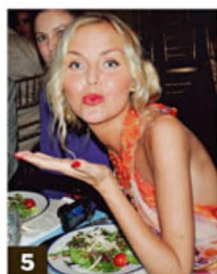


June 23: A dinner at the Pierre benefited the Duke of Edinburgh's International Award and Young Americans' Challenge. The award honors people age 14 to 25.

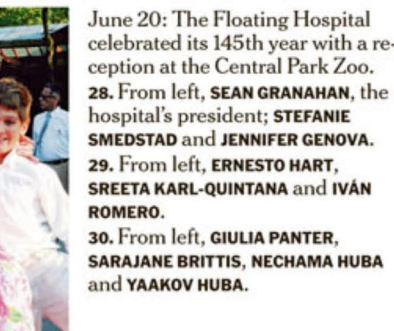
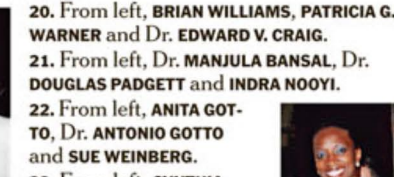
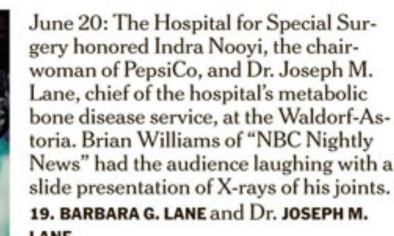
