Sizzling at the Joyce

Zap! Pilobolus Dance Theatre is turning up the voltage for the premiere of "Megawatt," a hair-raising spectacle set to the music of Radiohead and Primus, with choreography by Jonathan Wolken. Then the dance troupe, sizzled and smoking but still fearless, will go on to present two additional novelties, all during its upcoming New York season.

Alison Chase retells the story of Orpheus and Eurydice — from the dead woman's point of view — in her new work set to a score by Ed Bilous, but Michael Tracy is too busy choreographing his new duet to comment on it. Divided among three programs, the repertoire balances Pilobolus classics like "Day Two" with recent hits like last season's wacky "Wedlock." The company performs at 8 p.m. Mondays through Saturdays, and 2 p.m. Saturdays, June 21 through July 17, at the Joyce Theater, 175 Eighth Ave. at 19th Street. Tickets are \$40.
